

Sue C. Stivers Scholarship

Sponsored by Adair County Extension Homemakers

Each year a \$500 scholarship is available to an Adair County resident who is currently working toward a degree at the University of Kentucky in the Martin-Gatton College of Agriculture, Food and Environment OR perusing an Education degree at Lindsey Wilson College. Applicants should apply during the Spring semester of their Junior or Senior year. Junior and Senior status will be considered both by number of years in college and by number of credit hours attained.

A current college transcript must be provided with the application. For U.K. students this can be an unofficial transcript populated from your MyUK. Applicants should maintain a 3.0 on a 4-point scale in their coursework. Receipt of scholarship money from other sources does not disqualify an applicant from receiving this scholarship.

Adair County Extension Homemaker members of the scholarship committee will make the final selection from the applications. Upon verification of enrollment for the Fall semester of college, a check will be paid directly to the student to be applied toward tuition, fees, or books for the selected student.

Completed applications, with transcripts, must be submitted by midnight CST on May 31st, 2024. Submissions after office closing may be put in our drop box or emailed. Paper applications may be picked up and dropped off at the Adair County Cooperative Extension Service during normal operating hours.
