The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about January 29, 2023, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Fleeing or Evading the Police in the First Degree, contrary to KRS 520.095, and at that time the defendant was a person more than 21 years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of 1 year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of 18 years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one of the previous felony convictions within 5 years prior to the date of the commission of the offense of Fleeing or Evading the Police in the First Degree, contrary to KRS 520.095, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of January 29, 2023, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within 5 years prior to the date of January 29, 2023, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
