The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about May 22, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant appeared in a public place manifestly under the influence of a controlled substance, or other intoxicating substance, excluding alcohol, not therapeutically administered, to the degree that she may have endangered herself or other persons or property, or unreasonably annoyed persons in her vicinity, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about May 22, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Trafficking in a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when she knowingly and unlawfully trafficked in two (2) grams or more of methamphetamine, and at the time of the commission of the offense and in furtherance of the offense, the Defendant was in possession of a firearm, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about May 22, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when she knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about May 22, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Trafficking in a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree when she knowingly and unlawfully trafficked in twenty (20) or more, but less than one hundred twenty (120) dosage units of gabapentin, a Schedule V non-narcotic, and at the time of the commission of the offense and in furtherance of the offense, the Defendant was in possession of a firearm, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about May 22, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Trafficking in a Controlled Substance when she knowingly and unlawfully trafficked in a quantity of fentanyl, and at the time of the commission of the offense and in furtherance of the offense, the Defendant was in possession of a firearm, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle upon the highway at such time as his operator's license had been denied, canceled, suspended, or revoked, or his privilege to operate a motor vehicle had been withdrawn, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he failed to have a registration receipt in the vehicle, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he failed to have a registration plate on the vehicle or at such time as the registration plates on said vehicle were expired, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he failed to maintain a validly issued insurance card inside his vehicle as required by KRS Chapter 304, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the Defendant's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation of physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the influence of alcohol; or while the Defendant was under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impaired the Defendant's driving ability; or while the presence of a controlled substance listed in KRS 189A.010(12) was detected in the Defendant's blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, this being his second such offense within a ten (10) year period, and the Defendant refused to submit to any test or tests of his blood, breath, or urine requested by an officer having reasonable grounds to believe the Defendant was operating or in physical control of a motor vehicle in violation of Subsection (1) of KRS 189A.010, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed methamphetamine, this being a third or subsequent such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he failed to maintain security of required insurance on a motor vehicle, as required by KRS Chapter 304, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 9:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully failed to properly display a registration plate on the rear of his motor vehicle, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 10:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, having been convicted of a "sex crime" and having been designated as a "registrant" as such terms are defined in KRS 17.500, was on or loitered within one thousand (1,000) feet of the clearly defined grounds of a publicly owned or leased playground, and the Defendant did not have advance written permission from the local legislative body with jurisdiction over the publicly owned or leased playground, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 11:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully failed to display a proper registration plate on the rear of his motor vehicle, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant appeared in a public place manifestly under the influence of a controlled substance, or other intoxicating substance, excluding alcohol, not therapeutically administered, to the degree that he may have endangered himself or other persons or property, or unreasonably annoyed persons in his vicinity, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully and with the intent to mislead Kentucky State Trooper Jacob Harper, a peace officer, as to his identity, gave a false name and date of birth to the officer, who had asked for the Defendant's name, date of birth, and social security number in the lawful discharge of his official duties and had warned the Defendant that the giving of false identifying information is a criminal offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed or used any current or former identifying information of another person, with the intent to represent that he was the other person for the purpose of depriving the other person of property, or for the purpose of obtaining benefits or property to which he would otherwise not be entitled, or for the purpose of making financial or credit transactions using the other person's identity, or for the purpose of avoiding detection, or for the purpose of commercial or political benefit, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 18, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Theft of Identity, contrary to KRS 514.160, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of June 18, 2024, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of June 18, 2024, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of June 18, 2024, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
