COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 8, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully operated, exercised control over, or otherwise used a 2019 Dodge Ram truck, same being the movable property of [REDACTED] and/or [REDACTED] and/or another person(s), without the consent of the owner or person having legal possession thereof, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 8, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the Defendant's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation of physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the influence of alcohol; or while the Defendant was under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impaired the Defendant's driving ability; or while the presence of a controlled substance listed in KRS 189A.010(12) was detected in the Defendant's blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, this being his second such offense within a ten (10) year period, and the Defendant was operating a motor vehicle while the alcohol concentration in his blood or breath was 0.15 or more as measured by a test or tests of a sample of the Defendant's blood or breath taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation of the motor vehicle, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 8, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Disorderly Conduct in the Second Degree when, in a public place and with the intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance, or alarm, or wantonly creating a risk thereof, he engaged in fighting or in violent, tumultuous, or threatening behavior; made unreasonable noise; or he created a hazardous or physically offensive condition by an act that served no legitimate purpose, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 8, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Terroristic Threatening in the Third Degree when he threatened to commit any crime likely to result in the death or serious physical injury to another person or likely to result in substantial property damage to another person, when he threatened to kill Columbia Police Officer Trent Williams and other law enforcement officers, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 8, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he failed to maintain security covering the vehicle or required insurance on the motor vehicle, as required by KRS Chapter 304, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 8, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he failed to maintain a validly issued insurance card inside in the vehicle as required by KRS Chapter 304, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 8, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that he had such right, he intentionally or wantonly defaced, destroyed, or damaged a 2019 Dodge Ram truck, owned by [REDACTED] and/or [REDACTED] and/or another person, causing pecuniary loss of more than \$1,000, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky charges that on or about April 8, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle while his license was revoked or suspended under KRS Chapter 189A, this being his first such offense within a ten (10) year period, and at the time of the offense the defendant was also operating or in physical control of a motor vehicle in violation of KRS 189A.010(1)(a), (b), (c), (d), or (e), against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 26, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test(s) of a sample of the Defendant's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the under the influence of alcohol; or while the Defendant was under the influence of any other substance or combination of

substances which impaired the Defendant's driving ability; or while the presence of a controlled substance listed in KRS 189A.010(12) was detected in the Defendant's blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test(s) taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, this being his fourth or subsequent such offense within a ten (10) year period, and the Defendant was operating a motor vehicle while the alcohol concentration in his blood or breath was 0.15 or more as measured by a test or tests of a sample of the Defendant's blood or breath taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation of the motor vehicle, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 26, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle while his license was revoked or suspended under KRS Chapter 189A, this being his second such offense within a ten (10) year period, and at the time of the offense the defendant was also operating or in physical control of a motor vehicle in violation of KRS 189A.010(1)(a), (b), (c), (d), or (e), against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 26, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Operating a Motor Vehicle While Under the Influence of Alcohol .08, Fourth or Subsequent Offense, contrary to KRS 189A.010; and Driving DUI Suspended License, Second Offense (Aggravating Circumstance), contrary to KRS 189A.090, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of June 26, 2024, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of June 26, 2024, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of June 26, 2024, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
