COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about November 6, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed methamphetamine, this being a third or subsequent such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about November 6, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about November 6, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Fleeing or Evading the Police in the Third Degree when, as a pedestrian, and with the intent to elude or flee, he knowingly or wantonly disobeyed a direction to stop given by Kentucky State Trooper Carl Brandon Roark, who the defendant recognized to be a peace officer, and in fleeing or eluding the defendant created a substantial risk of physical injury to another person, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about November 6, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevented or attempted to prevent Kentucky State Trooper Carl Brandon Roark, who was recognized to be acting under color of official authority, from effecting an arrest of the defendant by using or threatening to use physical force or violence against Kentucky State Trooper Carl Brandon Roark, or by using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to Kentucky State Trooper Carl Brandon Roark, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about November 6, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully introduced methamphetamine, same being dangerous contraband, into the Adair County Regional Jail, or being a person confined in the Adair County Regional Jail, he knowingly made, obtained, or possessed methamphetamine, same being dangerous contraband, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about November 6, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Promoting Contraband in the First Degree, in violation of KRS 520.050, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of November 6, 2025, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of November 6, 2025, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of November 6, 2025, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone or in complicity with another person, knowingly and unlawfully possessed a Dremel tool, a battery powered grinder, and numerous other items, same being tools commonly used to commit or facilitate the commission of an offense involving forcible entry into premises or theft by a physical taking, with the intention to use same to commit such an offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone or in complicity with another person, knowingly and unlawfully possessed marijuana, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone or in complicity with another person, knowingly and unlawfully attempted to take or exercise control over a gray Freightliner Auto Carrier Rollback automobile, the movable property of [REDACTED], and/or another entity/person, with the intent to deprive the owner thereof, said property having a value of \$10,000 or more but less than \$1,000,000, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone or in complicity with another person, having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that he had such right, he intentionally or wantonly defaced, destroyed, or damaged property owned by [REDACTED], and/or another entity/person, by damaging the gates, the chain drive on the gate opener, padlock, the automatic Life Master Opener attached to the gate, the chain and the wiring, causing pecuniary loss of \$500 or more, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone or in complicity with another person, unlawfully removed, defaced, covered, altered, destroyed, or otherwise obscured the manufacturer's serial number or other distinguishing identification number or mark on a 2018 Ford Focus automobile, with the intent to render it unidentifiable; or he knowingly and unlawfully possessed a 2018 Ford Focus automobile, knowing that the serial number or other identification number or mark had been removed, defaced, covered, altered, destroyed, or otherwise obscured, said property having a value of \$10,000 or more, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone or in complicity with another person, received, retained, or disposed of a 2018 Ford Focus automobile, VIN / 1FADP3F21JL272246, same being the movable property of [REDACTED], and/or another person, and the defendant knew that the property had been stolen or had reason to believe that it had been stolen, and the defendant did not receive, retain, or dispose of the property with the intent to return it to the owner, said property having a value of \$10,000 or more, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone or in complicity with another person, knowingly and unlawfully possessed a Dremel tool, a battery powered grinder, and numerous other items, same being tools commonly used to commit or facilitate the commission of an offense involving forcible entry into premises or theft by a physical taking, with the intention to use same to commit such an offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone or in complicity with another person, knowingly and unlawfully possessed marijuana, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone or in complicity with another person, knowingly and unlawfully

attempted to take or exercise control over a gray Freightliner Auto Carrier Rollback, automobile, the movable property of [REDACTED], and/or another entity/person, with the intent to deprive the owner thereof, said property having a value of \$10,000 or more but less than \$1,000,000, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone or in complicity with another person, having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that he had such right, he intentionally or wantonly defaced, destroyed, or damaged property owned by [REDACTED] and/or another entity/person, by damaging the gates, the chain drive on the gate opener, padlock, the automatic Life Master Opener attached to the gate, the chain and the wiring, causing pecuniary loss of \$500 or more, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone or in complicity with another person, unlawfully removed, defaced, covered, altered, destroyed, or otherwise obscured the manufacturer's serial number or other distinguishing identification number or mark on a 2018 Ford Focus automobile, with the intent to render it unidentifiable; or he knowingly and unlawfully possessed a 2018 Ford Focus automobile, knowing that the serial number or other identification number or mark had been removed, defaced, covered, altered, destroyed, or otherwise obscured, said property having a value of \$10,000 or more, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, acting either alone or in complicity with another person, received, retained, or disposed of a 2018 Ford Focus automobile, VIN / 1FADP3F21JL272246, same being the movable property of [REDACTED] and/or another person, and the defendant knew that the property had been stolen or had reason to believe that it had been stolen, and the defendant did not receive, retain, or dispose of the property with the intent to return it to the owner, said property having a value of \$10,000 or more, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense(s) of Criminal Attempt to Commit Theft by Unlawful Taking/Disposition (Auto) - \$10,000 or more but less than \$1,000,000, in violation of KRS 506.010 & KRS 514.030; Criminal Mischief in the First Degree, in violation of KRS 512.020;

Obscuring the Identity of a Machine - \$10,000 or more, in violation of KRS 514.120; and Receiving Stolen Property - \$10,000 or more, in violation of KRS 514.110(3)(d), and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least one (1) prior felony offense, with the previous conviction being a conviction of a felony in this state or convicted of a crime in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offense was committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on the previous felony conviction within five (5) years prior to the date of December 21, 2025, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from the previous felony conviction as of the date of December 21, 2025, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on the previous felony conviction within five (5) years prior to the date of December 21, 2025, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
