ENHANCES PENALTY RANGE TO IMPRISONMENT FOR 10-20 YEARS

COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about October 11, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the Defendant's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation of physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the influence of alcohol; or while the Defendant was under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impaired the Defendant's driving ability; or while the presence of a controlled substance listed in KRS 189A.010(12) was detected in the Defendant's blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, this being his third such offense within a ten (10) year period, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about October 11, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle on a highway in a manner that was without regard for the safety and convenience of pedestrians and other vehicles upon the highway, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about October 11, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life, he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to [REDACTED] when he operated a motor vehicle on the roadway while intoxicated and in a wanton manner and thereby struck another vehicle in which [REDACTED] was a passenger, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about October 11, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life, he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to [REDACTED] when he operated a motor vehicle on the roadway while intoxicated and in a wanton manner and thereby struck another vehicle which was being operated by [REDACTED] against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about October 11, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense(s) of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree, two (2) counts, in violation of KRS 508.060, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date(s) of October 11, 2025, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date(s) of October 11, 2025, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date(s) of October 11, 2025, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 16 – 18, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant received, retained, or disposed of a tote full of metal farm tractor toys, assorted antiques, family photos, glassware, glass jar with a copper lid, assorted jewelry, coins, an antique yearbook, an antique notebook, a religious statue, a government road sign and metal post, a microscope, a barometer/thermometer wall decor, and/or miscellaneous other items of personal property, same being the movable property of [REDACTED], and/or another person, and the defendant knew that the property had been stolen or had reason to believe that it had been stolen, and the defendant did not receive, retain, or dispose of the property with the intent to return it to the owner, said property having a value of \$1,000 or more but less than \$10,000, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 1 – 2, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly entered or remained unlawfully in a barn/building on the property owned by [REDACTED] and/or another person, with the intent to commit a crime, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 1 – 2, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully entered or remained in or upon the premises of [REDACTED], and/or another person, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 1 – 2, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, knowingly and unlawfully took or exercised control over a new Craftsman compressor, a generator, a stick welder, two (2) skid steer wheels and tires, two (2) 20” wheels and tires, batteries for car & tractor, hydraulic fluid in 5-gallon buckets, oils, 10 gallons of diesel fuel siphoned from a skid steer, garden hoses, extension cords / electric wire, totes containing miscellaneous items for mission trips, and/or miscellaneous other items of personal property, same being the movable property of [REDACTED] and/or another person, with the intent to deprive the owner thereof, said property having a value of \$1,000 or more but less than \$10,000, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 2, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 2, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed methamphetamine, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 2, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevented or attempted to prevent Adair County Deputy Sheriff Josh Durbin and/or other law enforcement officers, who were recognized to be acting under color of official authority, from effecting an arrest of the defendant by using or threatening to use physical force or violence against Adair County Deputy Sheriff Josh Durbin and/or other law enforcement officers, or by using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to Adair County Deputy Sheriff Josh Durbin and/or other law enforcement officers, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 16 – 18, 2026, and on or about March 1 – 2, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense(s) of Receiving Stolen Property - \$1,000 or more but less than \$10,000, in violation of KRS 514.110; Burglary in the Third Degree, in violation of KRS 511.040; and Theft by Unlawful Taking/Disposition - \$1,000 or more but less than \$10,000, in violation of KRS 514.030, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date(s) of the commission of these offense(s), or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date(s) of the commission of these offense(s), or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date(s) of the commission of these offense(s), against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

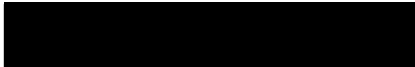
