COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 5, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the Defendant's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation of physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the influence of alcohol; or while the Defendant was under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impaired the Defendant's driving ability; or while the presence of a controlled substance listed in KRS 189A.010(12) was detected in the Defendant's blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, and at the time of the offense the Defendant was operating a motor vehicle in the wrong direction on a limited access highway, this being his first such offense within a ten (10) year period, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 5, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant drove a commercial vehicle within this state while having any measurable or detectable amount of alcohol or other controlled substances in his system, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 5, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life, he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to person(s) traveling on the Louie B. Nunn Cumberland Parkway, through his operation of a commercial motor vehicle, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 5, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally smelled or inhaled the fumes of a volatile substance which contained a solvent or chemical that had the property of releasing toxic vapors or fumes which when inhaled caused a condition of intoxication, inebriation, stupefaction, dulling of the brain or nervous system, or distortion or disturbance of the auditory, visual, or mental processes, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 5, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle on a highway in a manner that was without regard for the safety and convenience of pedestrians and other vehicles upon the highway, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 11, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle on the public roadways at such time as the Defendant failed to wear a properly adjusted and fastened seat belt, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 11, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the Defendant's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation of physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the influence of alcohol; or while the Defendant was under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impaired the Defendant's driving ability; or while the presence of a controlled substance listed in KRS 189A.010(12) was detected in the Defendant's blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, this being his second such offense within a ten (10) year period, and the Defendant refused to submit to any test or tests of his blood, breath, or urine requested by an officer having reasonable grounds to believe the Defendant was operating or in physical control of a motor vehicle in violation of Subsection (1) of KRS 189A.010, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 11, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed methamphetamine, this being a second such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 11, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 11, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Tampering With Physical Evidence when, believing that an official proceeding was pending or may be instituted, he destroyed, mutilated, concealed, removed, or altered physical evidence which he believed was about to be produced or used in the official proceeding with intent to impair its verity or availability in the official proceeding, when he attempted to conceal, remove, and/or destroy a quantity of methamphetamine, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 11, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Tampering with Physical Evidence, in violation of KRS 524.100, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of June 11, 2026, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of June 11, 2026, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of June 11, 2026, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
