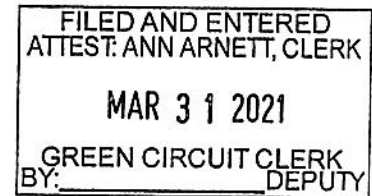

COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about January 3, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant unlawfully took or exercised control over movable property (valued over \$500.00) of another with intent to deprive him thereof; or obtains immovable property of another or any interest therein with intent to benefit himself or another not entitled thereto or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about January 3, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant whose operator's license has been denied, canceled, suspended or revoked, or whose privilege to operate a motor vehicle has been withdrawn, shall operate any motor vehicle upon the highways while the license is denied, canceled, suspended, or revoked or his privilege to operate a motor vehicle is withdrawn, or the license has not been applied for or

aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about January 23, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky the above-named defendant shall have his or her license in his or her immediate possession at all times when driving a motor vehicle and shall display it upon demand to the circuit clerk or examiner, a peace officer, a member of the Department of Kentucky State Police or a field deputy or inspector of the Department of Vehicle Regulation or Transportation Cabinet or, pursuant to KRS67A.075 or 83A.088. a safety officer who is in the process of securing information to complete an accident report or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:



COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 12, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevents or attempts to prevent a peace officer, recognized to be acting under color of his official authority from effecting an arrest of the actor or another by: using or threatening to use physical force or violence against the peace officer or another; or using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to the peace officer or another or aided, abetted or counseled



with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about February 12, 2021, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant when he or she: in a public place and with intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance, or alarm, or wantonly creating a risk thereof: engages in fighting or in violent, tumultuous, or threatening behavior; make unreasonable noise; or refuses to obey an official order to disperse issued to maintain public safety in dangerous proximity to a fire, hazard, or other emergency; or creates a hazardous or physically offensive condition by any act that serves no legitimate purpose or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
