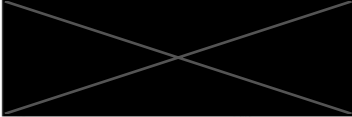

KRS: 189A.010 – Operating Motor Vehicle under Influence Alcohol (189A.010(1B) 4th or > Offense (Class D Felony) (UOR 031760)

COUNT 2

KRS: 532.080(2) – Persistent Felony Offender – Second Degree (UOR 73102)

COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about October 24, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person’s breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one’s driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one’s driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person’s breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 24, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant is over the age of 21 and stood convicted of at least one


felony after his 18th birthday. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2

KRS:218A.500(2) – Drug Paraphernalia-Buy/Possess, (Class A Misdemeanor) (UOR 42081)

COUNT 3

KRS: 189A.010 – Operating Motor Vehicle under Influence Alcohol/Substances (Class B Misdemeanor) (UOR 31260)

COUNT 4

KRS: 189.040(1) – One Headlight (Violation) (UOR 2260)

COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about September 23, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully was trafficking in Ten (10) or more dosage units of a controlled substance classified in Schedules I and II that is not a narcotic drug; or specified in KRS 218A.1412, and which is not a synthetic drug, salvia, or marijuana; or Twenty (20) or more dosage units of a controlled substance classified in schedule III; He or she knowingly and unlawfully prescribes, distributes, supplies, or sells an anabolic steroid for: Enhancing human performance in an exercise, sport or game; or Hormonal manipulation intended to increase muscle mass, strength or weight in the human species without a medical necessity; or he or she knowingly and unlawfully traffics in any quantity of a controlled substance specified in paragraph (a) of this subsection in an amount less than the amounts specified in that paragraph or aided, abetted, or counseled with another in commission of said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about September 23, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed drug paraphernalia. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about September 23, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about September 23, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating at motor vehicle with only one working headlight or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth.
