The Grand Jury charges: That on or about June 11, 2023, through June 13, 2023, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant unlawfully took or exercised control over movable property of another with intent to deprive him or her thereof; or Obtains immovable property of another or any interest therein with intent to benefit himself or herself or another not entitled thereto or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about June 11, 2023, through June 13, 2023, in Green

County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he wantonly engages in conduct which creates a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person or aided abetted or counseled with another in said act. COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 6, 2023, through May 7, 2023, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant while operating a motor vehicle with intent to elude or flee, the person knowingly or wantonly disobeys a direction to stop his or her motor

vehicle, given by a person recognized to be a police officer and at least (1) of the following conditions exists: the person is fleeing immediately after committing an act of domestic violence as defined in KRS 403.720 the person is driving under the influence of alcohol or any other substance or combination of substance in violation of KRS 189A.010; the person is driving while his or her driver's license is suspended for violating KRS 189A.010; or be fleeing or eluding, the person is the cause, or creates substantial risk, of serious physical injury or death of any person or property; or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about August 9, 2022, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life wantonly engage in conduct which creates substantial danger of death to another person or engages in conduct which creates substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person or aided abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 6, 2023, through May 7, 2023, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevents or attempts to prevent a peace officer, recognized to be acting under color of his official authority from effecting an arrest of the actor or another by: using or threatening to use physical force or violence against the peace officer or another; or using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to the peace officer or another or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about May 6, 2023, through May 7, 2023, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant who has not applied for an operator's license or whose operator's license has been denied, canceled, suspended, or revoked, or whose privilege to operate a motor vehicle upon the highways while the license is denied, canceled, suspended, or revoked or his privilege to operate a motor vehicle is withdrawn, or the license has not been applied for or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 6, 2023, through May 7, 2023, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed marijuana or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about May 6, 2023, through May 7, 2023 in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of


operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about May 6, 2023 through May 7, 2023, in Green County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant is over the age of 21 and stood convicted of at least two felonies after his 18th birthday **OR** one (1) or more felony sex crimes against a minor as defined in KRS 17.500, and now stands convicted of any one (1) or more felonies. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
