COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life, he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person when he operated a motor vehicle on the roadway while intoxicated and in a wanton manner and thereby struck another vehicle that was being operated by [REDACTED] thereby endangering the life of [REDACTED] against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life, he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person when he operated a motor vehicle on the roadway while intoxicated and in a wanton manner and thereby struck another vehicle in which [REDACTED] (a minor child whose date of birth is [REDACTED] was a passenger, thereby endangering the life of [REDACTED] (a minor child whose date of birth is [REDACTED]), against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle which was involved in an accident and the defendant, failed to report the accident in a reasonable amount of time to a public safety answering point, law enforcement agency, or law enforcement officer having jurisdiction, as required by KRS Chapter 189.580, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was the operator of a motor vehicle which was involved in an accident resulting in damage to a vehicle or other property which was driven or attended by any person, and failed to immediately stop and ascertain the extent of the damage and render reasonable assistance and provide information to such other person as required by KRS 189.580, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle on a highway in a manner that was without regard for the safety and convenience of pedestrians and other vehicles upon the highway, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he failed to have a valid registration receipt in the vehicle, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he failed to have a valid registration plate on the vehicle or at such time as the registration plates on said vehicle were expired, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he failed to maintain a validly issued insurance card inside his vehicle as required by KRS Chapter 304, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 9:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he failed to maintain security covering the vehicle or required insurance on the motor vehicle, as required by KRS Chapter 304, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 10:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to wear a properly adjusted and fastened seat belt, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 11:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant had in his possession an open alcoholic beverage container in the passenger area of a motor vehicle located on a public highway or on the right-of-way of a public highway, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 12:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that he had such right, he intentionally or wantonly defaced, destroyed, or damaged approximately twenty (20) feet of guard rail on the Cumberland Parkway, causing pecuniary loss of more than \$1,000.00, the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 13:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 15, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the Defendant's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation of physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the influence of alcohol; or while the Defendant was under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impaired the Defendant's driving ability; or while the presence of a controlled substance listed in KRS 189A.010(12) was detected in the Defendant's blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, this being his second such offense within a ten (10) year period, and the Defendant was operating a motor vehicle while the alcohol concentration in the operator's blood or breath was 0.15 or more as measured by a test or tests of a sample of the operator's blood or breath taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation of the motor vehicle, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about August 17, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Promoting Contraband in the First Degree, contrary to KRS 520.050, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who

stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of August 17, 2024, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of August 17, 2024, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of August 17, 2024, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 4 – 5, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Tampering With Physical Evidence when, believing that an official proceeding was pending or may be instituted, she destroyed, mutilated, concealed, removed, or altered physical evidence which she believed was about to be produced or used in the official proceeding with intent to impair its verity or availability in the official proceeding; or she fabricated physical evidence with the intent that it be introduced in the official proceeding or she offered physical evidence, knowing it to be fabricated or altered, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 4 – 5, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant possessed or uttered a forged medical document which purported to be from Hartland Women’s Healthcare containing the forged signature of [REDACTED], M.D., with the knowledge that said medical document was forged, and with the intent to defraud, deceive or injure another, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
