COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Murder when he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a grave risk of death to another person(s), by operating a motor vehicle under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to human life, and thereby caused the death of [REDACTED] against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test(s) of a sample of the Defendant's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the influence of alcohol; or while the Defendant was under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impaired the Defendant's driving ability; or while the presence of a controlled substance listed in KRS 189A.010(12) was detected in the Defendant's blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test(s) taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, this being his third such offense within a ten (10) year period, and the Defendant was operating a motor vehicle that caused an accident resulting in death or serious physical injury as defined in KRS 500.080, and/or the defendant refused to submit to a test of his breath requested by an officer having reasonable grounds to believe the Defendant was operating or in physical control of a motor vehicle in violation of KRS 189A.010(1), against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Assault in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a grave risk of death to another person(s) and thereby caused serious physical injury to [REDACTED], against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Assault in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a grave risk of death to another person(s) and thereby caused serious physical injury to [REDACTED] against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant wantonly caused physical injury to Townya Ritzie, or with recklessness he caused physical injury to [REDACTED] by means of a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant wantonly caused physical injury to West Morgan, or with recklessness he caused physical injury to [REDACTED] by means of a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed marijuana, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offenses of Murder, contrary to KRS 507.020; and Assault in the First Degree [two (2) counts], contrary to KRS 508.010, and at that time the defendant was a person

more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of December 21, 2024, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of December 21, 2024, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of December 21, 2024, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant appeared in a public place manifestly under the influence of alcohol to the degree that he may have endangered himself or other persons or property, or unreasonably annoyed persons in his vicinity, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Assault in the Third Degree upon Adair County Constable [REDACTED] who was a state, county, city, or federal peace officer, when the Defendant intentionally or wantonly caused physical injury to [REDACTED] or when the Defendant recklessly caused physical injury to [REDACTED] by means of a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Assault in the Third Degree upon [REDACTED] who is the Fire Chief of the Columbia/Adair County Fire Department, by intentionally causing or attempting to cause physical injury to [REDACTED] while [REDACTED] was performing job-related duties, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Terroristic Threatening in the Third Degree when he threatened to commit any crime likely to result in the death or serious physical injury to another person or likely to result in substantial property damage to another person, when he threatened to stab Adair County Constable [REDACTED], against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Disorderly Conduct in the Second Degree when, in a public place and with the intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance or alarm, or wantonly creating

a risk thereof, he engaged in fighting or in violent, tumultuous, or threatening behavior, or he made unreasonable noise, or he refused to obey an official order to disperse issued to maintain public safety in dangerous proximity to a fire, hazard or other emergency, or when he created a hazardous or physically offensive condition by an act that served no legitimate purpose, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 21, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally obstructed, impaired, or hindered the performance of a governmental function by using or threatening to use violence, force or physical interference, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about October 22, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Tampering With Physical Evidence when, believing that an official proceeding was pending or may be instituted, he destroyed, mutilated, concealed, removed, or altered physical evidence which he believed was about to be produced or used in the official proceeding with intent to impair its verity or availability in the official proceeding, when he

attempted to conceal, remove, and/or destroy a brown-like substance believed to be heroin, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about October 22, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally or wantonly caused physical injury to [REDACTED] or he recklessly caused physical injury to [REDACTED] by means of a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument, when the Defendant hit/shoved/pushed [REDACTED] and she was thrown from the bathroom into the hallway wall and onto the floor, causing injuries to her right arm and right wrist, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about October 22, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevented or attempted to prevent Columbia Police Officer Chris Tweedy and/or Columbia Police Officer Elliot Smith, who were recognized to be acting under color of official authority, from effecting an arrest of the defendant by using or threatening to use physical force or violence against Columbia Police Officer Chris Tweedy and/or Columbia Police Officer Elliot Smith, or by using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to Columbia Police Officer Chris Tweedy and/or Columbia Police Officer Elliot Smith, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about October 22, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense(s) of Tampering with Physical Evidence, contrary to KRS 524.100, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of October 22, 2024, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of October 22, 2024, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of October 22, 2024 against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
