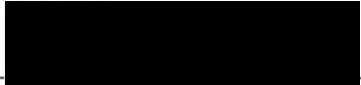
COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 8, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Assault in the Third Degree upon Adair County Deputy Jailer [REDACTED] an employee at the Adair County Regional Jail, which is a detention facility, when the defendant, being a person confined in the Adair County Regional Jail, intentionally caused or attempted to cause physical injury to [REDACTED] against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

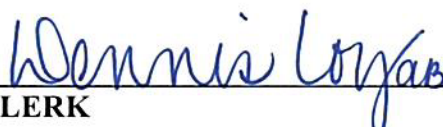
The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about June 8, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Assault in the Third Degree, in violation of KRS 508.025, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of June 8, 2025, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of June 8, 2025, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of June 8, 2025, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 13, 2024, through on or about August 26, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, on at least five (5) separate occasions, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed or viewed matter portraying a sexual performance by a minor when, having knowledge of its content, character, and that the sexual performance was by a minor, he knowingly had in his possession or control any matter which visually depicts an actual sexual performance by a minor person or computer-generated image of a minor person; or he intentionally viewed any matter which visually depicts an actual sexual performance by a minor person or computer-generated image of a minor person, and the Defendant knew that the minor or computer-generated image of the minor person portrayed was less than twelve (12) years old at the time of the sexual performance, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNTS 6-10:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 13, 2024, through on or about August 26, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, on at least five (5) separate occasions, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed or viewed matter portraying a sexual performance by a minor when, having knowledge of its content, character, and that the sexual performance was by a minor, he knowingly had in his possession or control any matter which visually depicts an actual sexual performance by a minor person or computer-generated image of a minor person; or he intentionally viewed any matter which visually depicts an actual sexual performance by a minor person or computer-generated image of a minor person, and the Defendant knew that the minor or computer-generated image of the minor person portrayed was over twelve (12) years old but less than eighteen (18) years old at the time of the sexual performance, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 11:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 13, 2024, through on or about February 27, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully used a communications system, including computers, computer networks, computer bulletin boards, cellular telephones,

or any other electronic means, for the purpose of procuring or promoting the use of a minor for any activity in violation of KRS 510.040, 510.050, 510.060, 510.070, 510.080, 510.090, 510.110, 529.100 where that offense involves commercial sexual activity, or 530.064(1)(a), or KRS Chapter 531, and said minor was under twelve (12) years of age, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 12:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 27, 2024, through on or about May 4, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully used a communications system, including computers, computer networks, computer bulletin boards, cellular telephones, or any other electronic means, for the purpose of procuring or promoting the use of a minor for any activity in violation of KRS 510.040, 510.050, 510.060, 510.070, 510.080, 510.090, 510.110, 529.100 where that offense involves commercial sexual activity, or 530.064(1)(a), or KRS Chapter 531, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

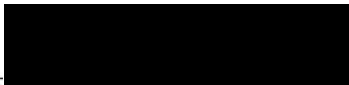

COUNT 14:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about January 23, 2025, through on or about February 2, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully used a communications system, including computers, computer networks, computer bulletin boards, cellular telephones, or any other electronic means, for the purpose of procuring or promoting the use of a minor for any activity in violation of KRS 510.040, 510.050, 510.060, 510.070, 510.080, 510.090, 510.110, 529.100 where that offense involves commercial sexual activity, or 530.064(1)(a), or KRS Chapter 531, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 27, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle on a highway in a manner that was without regard for the safety and convenience of pedestrians and other vehicles upon the highway, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 27, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he failed to have a registration plate on the vehicle or at such time as the registration plates on said vehicle were expired, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 27, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 27, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed methamphetamine, this being a second such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 27, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the Defendant's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation of physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the influence of alcohol; or while the Defendant was under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impaired the Defendant's driving ability; or while the presence of a controlled

substance listed in KRS 189A.010(12) was detected in the Defendant's blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, this being his second such offense within a ten (10) year period, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
