The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 12, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, while operating a motor vehicle with the intent to elude or flee, she knowingly or wantonly disobeyed a direction to stop her motor vehicle, given by a person recognized to be a police officer, and the defendant was driving under the influence of alcohol or any other substance or combination of substances in violation of KRS 189A.010; and/or by fleeing or eluding, the defendant was the cause, or created a substantial risk, of serious physical injury or death to another person(s) or property, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 12, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life, she wantonly engaged in conduct which created a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person(s) by operating a motor vehicle in a wanton manner during a police pursuit and thereby endangering the life of Adair County Deputy Sheriff Joey Keith, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 12, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life, she wantonly engaged in conduct which created a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person(s) by operating a motor vehicle in a wanton manner during a police pursuit and thereby endangering the life of Adair County Deputy Sheriff Nick Barber, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about September 12, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that she had such right, she intentionally or wantonly defaced, destroyed, or damaged a 2019 Dodge Charger police cruiser, owned by the Adair County Sheriff's Office, and/or another entity, causing pecuniary loss of \$500 or more, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

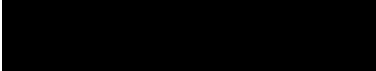

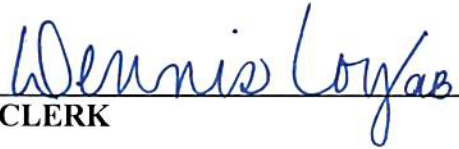

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 23, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully took or exercised control over a gooseneck trailer, same being the moveable property of [REDACTED] and/or another person, with the intent to deprive the owner thereof, said property having a value of \$1,000 or more but less than \$10,000, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 13, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully took or exercised control over numerous items of garage tools, numerous items of garden tools, numerous household items, numerous antique items, numerous Civil War items, numerous military items, and/or numerous and miscellaneous other items of personal property, same being the moveable property of [REDACTED] and/or another person, with the intent to deprive the owner thereof, said property having a value of \$10,000 or more but less than \$1,000,000.00, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

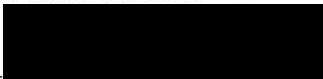

First Degree, contrary to KRS 512.020, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of July 13, 2025, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of July 13, 2025, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of July 13, 2025, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
